Synopsis: The increasing demand by Stakeholders in the Public Sector, including but not limited to Development Partners, for Accountability, Transparency and Integrity in Public Finance Management has influenced in no small measure, the adoption of the International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) by Public Sector Entities (PSEs).

Given the enormous work involved in a successful adoption and implementation of accrual basis IPSAS, the buy-in/support at the highest levels of government is a critical success factor.

The objective of this seminar therefore, is to simulate real world issues often encountered before, during and after transitioning to Accrual Basis IPSAS. The seminar shall provide a platform for advocacy on the roles of key leaders of governments regarding the minimum resource requirements (processes and systems) necessary for project success.
